## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Seven.

### AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR STANDARD ADMINISTRATION OF FIRST-AID MEDICAL SERVICES TO STATE EMPLOYEES DURING THEIR HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 That the commissioner of administration shall, subject to  
2 the approval of the commission on administration and finance  
3 and the governor and council, make rules and regulations  
4 which shall regulate first-aid medical services and medical  
5 care for permanent and temporary employees of the common-  
6 wealth during their hours of employment and for state em-  
7 ployees residing in state-owned or state-controlled dwelling  
8 facilities in any institution under the department of mental  
9 health, public health, public welfare or correction or in the  
10 soldiers' homes in Massachusetts or in institutions under  
11 the jurisdiction of the youth service board or in any institu-  
12 tion under the department of education.
