AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE EXCISE UPON CHARGES FOR MEALS SERVED TO THE PUBLIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 64B of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out "including cover and other charges"
3 so as to read as follows: — Taxable charge, — any amount
4 charged for meals whenever furnished within the common-
5 wealth, for which the purchaser is charged as a total one dol-
6 lar or more, except meals exempt under section two A.
