RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE MODERNIZING OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist
2 of two members of the senate to be designated by the presi-
3 dent thereof, three members of the house of representatives
4 to be designated by the speaker thereof, and two persons to be
5 appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the
6 purpose of making an investigation and study of the motor
7 vehicle laws of the commonwealth relative to the desirability
8 of modernizing them. Said commission shall be provided
9 with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hear-
10 ings, may travel within and without the commonwealth and
11 may expend for clerical and other services and expenses such
12 sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said commission
13 shall report to the general court the results of its investigation
14 and study and its recommendations, if any, together with
15 drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations
16 into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
17 representatives not later than the first Wednesday of Decem-
18 ber in the current year.
