AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN AN OFF-SHORE SAFETY BARRIER AT ORIENT HEIGHTS BEACH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct and maintain at the
3 Orient Heights beach, an off-shore log boom, buoyed rope line,
4 or other safety barrier in the waters of said beach for protec-
5 tion of swimmers and bathers using said beach.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act, the commission is
2 hereby authorized to expend such sums as may be appro-
3 priated therefor.
