AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMPENSATION OF SCHOOL COMMITTEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 52, as most recently amended by chapter
3 90 of the acts of 1932, and inserting in place thereof the fol-
4 lowing section:—

5 *Section 52.* A city or town may vote to compensate the
6 members of its school committee. No member of a school
7 committee in any town shall be eligible to the position of
8 teacher, or superintendent of public schools therein, or in
9 any union school or superintendency union or district in
10 which his town participates.
