

HOUSE No. 1031

By Mr. Hickey of Boston, petition of the Permanent Pension Fund Association for increasing the amount of pensions payable under the permanent school pension fund in the city of Boston. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT INCREASING PENSIONS PAYABLE UNDER THE PERMANENT SCHOOL PENSION FUND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 468 of the acts of 1951, as amended
2 by chapter 594 of the acts of 1955, is hereby amended by
3 striking out sections 6 and 7 and inserting in place thereof
4 the following two sections:—

5 *Section 6.* The pension payable to any member retired
6 under section five of this act shall be as follows:— If the
7 member shall have been retired after service for a period
8 aggregating thirty years or more, ten of which shall have
9 been in the employ of the school committee, such member
10 shall receive an annual pension of eighteen hundred dollars.
11 If the member shall have been retired after service for a period
12 aggregating less than thirty years, ten of which shall have
13 been in the employ of the school committee, such member
14 shall receive an annual pension which bears the same ratio
15 to eighteen hundred dollars as the total number of years of
16 service of such member bears to thirty; provided, that the
17 annual pension of such member shall be not less than twelve
18 hundred dollars.

19 *Section 7.* The amount of the pension of every person

20 retired before the effective date of this act under chapter five
21 hundred and eighty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and
22 eight, as from time to time amended, and the amount of the
23 pension of every person retired under this act prior to Septem-
24 ber first, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, shall be re-estab-
25 lished in accordance with the provisions of this act, to date
26 from said September first; and the amount of the pension
27 of every person granted before the effective date of this act a
28 pension under section four of chapter six hundred and seven-
29 teen of the acts of nineteen hundred and ten, as amended,
30 shall be re-established at the minimum amount payable under
31 the last sentence of section six of this act, to date from said
32 September first. Nothing in this act as amended shall be
33 construed to decrease the amount of any pension being paid
34 to any person.

1 SECTION 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed to dimin-
2 ish the reimbursements provided for by section two of chapter
3 six hundred and seventy-four of the acts of nineteen hundred
4 and forty-seven and paragraph (c) of subdivision (2) of section
5 twenty of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance,
2 during the current year, by vote of the city council of the city
3 of Boston, subject to the provisions of its charter, but not
4 otherwise.
