AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF COUNTY TUBERCULOSIS HOSPITAL TRUSTEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 87 of chapter 111 of the General Laws,
2 as amended by section 1 of chapter 398 of the acts of 1945, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 1 and 2, the
4 words "Except as otherwise provided for the tuberculosis
5 hospital for Bristol county, county" and inserting in place
6 thereof the word:— County, — so as to read as follows:—

7 *Section 87.* County commissioners shall be trustees of the
8 hospitals erected under sections seventy-eight to ninety,
9 inclusive, shall make suitable regulations for their govern-
10 ment, and shall appoint superintendents and other officers
11 and employees necessary for the proper conduct thereof.
12 The superintendents and other physicians employed shall be
13 appointed subject to the approval of the department.

1 SECTION 2. Section eighty-seven A of said chapter one
2 hundred and eleven is hereby repealed.
