AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FILLING OF VACANCIES IN CITY, WARD AND TOWN COMMITTEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 52 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 6, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 346
3 of the acts of 1938, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 6.* A vacancy in the office of chairman, secretary or
6 treasurer of a city, ward or town committee, or in the member-
7 ship of a ward or town committee, shall be filled by such com-
8 mittee from among the enrolled members of the party resident
9 in such city, ward or town, and a statement of any such
10 change shall be filed as in the case of the officers and members
11 first chosen. If any member shall change his residence from
12 the city, ward or town in which he was chosen to fill said
13 vacancy he shall cease to be a member at the end of the calen-
14 dar year during which said residence is changed.
