AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO MAKE CERTAIN CHANGES RELATIVE TO INDICATORS ON TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is hereby au-  
2 thorized and directed to alter, amend or otherwise change the  
3 mechanical standards of the indicators on traffic control signals  
4 so that the circumference of the area covered by glass and the  
5 illuminating power provided thereto shall be increased.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
