exceed five years; provided, however, that all such bonds shall be payable by June thirtieth, two thousand and ten, as recommended by the governor in a message to the general court dated November second, nineteen hundred and ninety-five, in pursuance of Section 3 of Article LXII of the Amendments to the Constitution.

**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the notes which the state treasurer is authorized to issue under section four of chapter one hundred and thirty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and ninety-five, shall be issued and may be renewed one or more times not exceeding one year; and the final maturities of such notes whether original or renewal, shall be no later than June thirtieth, two thousand and two, as recommended by the governor in a message to the general court dated November second, nineteen hundred and ninety-five, in pursuance of Section 3 of Article LXII of the Amendments to the Constitution.

**Chapter 4. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TOWN MANAGER IN THE TOWN OF SHREWSBURY.**

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 7 of chapter 559 of the acts of 1953 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 13 and 14, the words "or appointive".

**Chapter 5. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT PROGRAM OF THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY.**

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is relative to the retirement program of the Massachusetts Port Authority, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter 133 of the acts of 1992 is hereby amended by striking out section 49 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-
