RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A PROPER REPRESENTATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH AT THE NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE JEWISH WAR VETERANS TO BE HELD AT BOSTON IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

1 *Resolved*, That, in order that the commonwealth may be
2 properly represented at the national convention of the
3 Jewish War Veterans to be held at the city of Boston on
4 August twelfth to seventeenth, inclusive, in the current
5 year, and to ensure, in arranging entertainments and other
6 events in connection therewith, proper co-operation between
7 said Jewish War Veterans and the commonwealth, there may
8 be expended, with the approval and under the direction of
9 the governor and council, for said purpose, a sum not exceed-
10 ing twenty-five thousand dollars.
