AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF CERTAIN FINES
BY CITIES AND TOWNS FOR SCHOOL BUILDING PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 280 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the last sentence, as inserted
3 by section 1 of chapter 303 of the acts of 1935, and inserting
4 in place thereof the following:— Fines imposed under the
5 provisions of chapter ninety for parking violations and speed-
6 ing violations shall be paid over to the cities and towns wherein
7 said offences were committed. All other fines imposed under
8 the provisions of chapter ninety shall be paid over to the
9 treasury of the county wherein the offence was committed.

1 SECTION 2. A city or town receiving sums of money under
2 the preceding section of this act shall expend said sums for
3 school building construction, maintenance and repair purposes
4 only.
