AN ACT RELATIVE TO DUTIES OF DISTRICT COURT CLERKS IN APPELLATE MATTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 12 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as amended,
2 is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the section
3 the following paragraph:—

4 In all cases of appeals to the appellate division it shall be
5 the duty of the clerk of the district court of originaljur isdic-
6 tion to notify counsel in clear, unambiguous language of the
7 dates when pleadings must be filed. Failure of the clerk to do
8 so shall not result in penalties to the parties or their counsel.

the Committee of Government

in the year that the President and Vice President

shall be elected by the electors in the manner provided in the Constitution and laws of the United States

and the electors in each State shall have the qualifications in each State as electors in the election of the President and Vice President

no elector shall have a civil disability in either of the States in which he resides or in which he is at the time of his election

the electors shall meet in person or by ballot in the State in which they reside or in which they are at the time of their meeting

the electors shall vote for President and Vice President by ballot and shall be sworn before they vote
