By Mr. Perkins of Hingham, petition of Robert W. Bouve and others that the harbor masters of Hingham and Hull be authorized to control the movements of boats in Weir River and adjoining shores. Public Safety.

AN ACT TO ENABLE THE HARBOR MASTERS OF HINGHAM AND HULL, UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THEIR RESPECTIVE SELECTMEN, TO CONTROL THE MOVEMENTS OF SMALL BOATS, YACHTS, ETC., IN WEIR RIVER AND ADJOINING SHORES, ISLANDS, CHANNELS AND FAIRWAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The harbor master of Hingham and/or Hull to enforce
2 speed and noise regulations, designate anchorages and moor-
3 ing locations and regulations to do with waste disposal on
4 the shores or in the waters of Weir river and adjoining shores,
5 etc. The selectmen to issue licenses for boat liveries and other
6 commercial ventures. All above referred to regulations to be
7 drawn up by the selectmen of the two towns with penalties
8 for each violation to be no less than ten dollars nor above
9 one hundred dollars.

By the Order of the House, passed on the 11th of March, 1870, the following resolution was adopted: "Resolved, That the Committee on the Judiciary be and they are authorized to report to the House the result of their investigation into the conduct of the late President Grant, and to report thereon to the House at such time as may be ordered by the House."
