By Mr. Perkins of Hingham, petition of Cecil Evans and others that the harbor masters of Hingham and Weymouth be authorized to control the movements of boats in Weymouth Back River and adjoining shores. Public Safety.

AN ACT TO ENABLE THE HARBOR MASTERS OF HINGHAM AND WEYMOUTH, UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THEIR RESPECTIVE SELECTMEN, TO CONTROL THE MOVEMENTS OF SMALL BOATS, YACHTS, ETC., IN WEYMOUTH BACK RIVER AND ADJOINING SHORES, ISLANDS, CHANNELS AND FAIRWAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The harbor master of Hingham and/or Weymouth to en-
2 force speed and noise regulations, designate anchorages and
3 mooring locations and regulations to do with waste disposal
4 on the shores or in the waters of Weymouth Back river and
5 adjoining shores, etc. The selectmen to issue licenses for
6 boat liveries and other commercial ventures. All above re-
7 ferred to regulations to be drawn up by the selectmen of the
8 two towns with penalties for each violation to be no less than
9 ten dollars nor above one hundred dollars.
