RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO SELECTING A SITE FOR A GOVERNOR'S MANSION READILY ACCESSIBLE TO BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 three members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, five members of the house of representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker thereof, and two persons to be
5 appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the pur-
6 pose of making an investigation and study relative to the
7 selection of an appropriate site for a governor's mansion
8 which will be readily accessible to Boston. Said commission
9 may expend for such purpose such sums of money as may be
10 appropriated therefor. Said commission shall report to the
11 general court the results of its investigation and its recom-
12 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation neces-
13 sary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the
14 same with the clerk of the house of representatives not later
15 than the first Wednesday in December in the current year.
