By Mr. Asiaf of Brockton, petition of John George Asiaf for legislation to prohibit the sale of alcoholic beverages at horse and dog racing meetings. Legal Affairs.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT
HORSE AND DOG RACING MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the General
2 Laws or any rule or regulation made thereunder, it is hereby
3 provided that sales of alcoholic beverages are prohibited upon
4 the grounds and premises wherein are held horse and dog
5 racing meetings.

1 SECTION 2. Any such sale by an agent or employee of a
2 person or association licensed to hold said racing meeting or
3 any such sale by a concessionaire of said licensee or agent or
4 employee of said concessionaire shall make the said licensee
5 subject to a fine of not more than five hundred dollars.
