AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNT OF PENSION TO BE PAID TO ALICE H. SPAULDING UPON HER RETIREMENT FROM THE BROOKLINE SCHOOL SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
2 law to the contrary, Alice H. Spaulding, a teacher in the
3 Brookline school system, shall receive, subject to the ap-
4 proval of the school committee, the sum of two thousand
5 dollars annually as a pension upon her retirement.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT PASSED IN THE YEAR 1859, RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Assembly, the 15th day of February, 1860.

1. That the words "the persons of any gender or color" in the first section of the act passed in the year 1859, be amended so as to read "the persons of any gender or color, and of any race or color."
2. That the words "and of any race or color" in the second section of the said act, be amended so as to read "and of any race or color, and of any sex or color."
3. That the words "and of any sex or color" in the third section of the said act, be amended so as to read "and of any sex or color, and of any race or color."
4. That the words "and of any race or color" in the fourth section of the said act, be amended so as to read "and of any race or color, and of any sex or color."
5. That the words "and of any sex or color" in the fifth section of the said act, be amended so as to read "and of any sex or color, and of any race or color."
