AN ACT TO PLACE THE BOSTON POLICE DEPARTMENT ON THE SAME SALARY SCHEDULE AS THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION POLICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section  
2 thirteen of chapter two hundred and ninety-one of the acts of  
3 nineteen hundred and six, as amended, the salary schedule  
4 of the Boston police department shall be based on and equal  
5 to that of the Metropolitan District police.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its accept-  
2 ance by vote of the city council of said city, but not otherwise.

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE SEVERAL ACTS RELATIVE TO THE BANK OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1.
