By Mr. Chmura of Holyoke, petition of Stephen T. Chmura that the Commissioner of Airport Management be authorized to continue development and improvement of the General Edward Lawrence Logan International Airport at East Boston. Aeronautics.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Seven.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTINUED DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE GENERAL EDWARD LAWRENCE LOGAN AIRPORT AT EAST BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of airport management is
2 hereby authorized and directed to further improve and de-
3 velop the General Edward Lawrence Logan Airport, includ-
4 ing construction of buildings thereon for hangars, maintenance
5 and repair shops and other necessary facilities, and to com-
6 plete certain work already started, with the approval of the
7 state airport management board; provided, however, that
8 such enlargement, extension, improvement or development of
9 the airport under the provisions of this section shall not per-
10 mit the extension of the existing bounds toward the town of
11 Winthrop or the mainland of the East Boston district of the
12 city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. To meet the expenditures necessary in carrying
2 out the provisions of this act, the state treasurer shall, upon
3 request of the governor and council, issue and sell at public or

4 private sale bonds of the commonwealth, registered or with
5 interest coupons attached, as he may deem best, to an amount
6 to be specified by the governor and council from time to time,
7 but not exceeding, in the aggregate, the sum of dollars.
8 All bonds issued by the commonwealth, as aforesaid, shall be
9 designated on their face, "Logan Airport Improvement Loan
10 of nineteen hundred and fifty-seven," and shall be on the
11 serial payment plan for such maximum term of years, not
12 exceeding nine years, as the governor may recommend to the
13 general court pursuant to section 3 of Article LXII of the
14 Amendments to the Constitution of the commonwealth, the
15 maturities thereof to be so arranged that the amounts payable
16 in the several years other than the final year shall be as nearly
17 equal as in the opinion of the state treasurer it is practicable
18 to make them. Said bonds shall bear interest semi-annually
19 at such rate as the state treasurer, with the approval of the
20 governor, shall fix, but such bonds shall be payable not earlier
21 than July first, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, nor later
22 than June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and sixty-five.

1 SECTION 3. Any funds received by the commonwealth from
2 the federal government for airport purposes for projects au-
3 thorized by this act shall be used to reduce the amount of
4 bonds issued under this act.
