By Mr. Weinberg of Boston, petition of John B. Hynes relative to providing for parking of motor vehicles on alternate sides of public ways in the city of Boston on alternate nights. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR PARKING ON ALTERNATE SIDES OF PUBLIC WAYS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON ON ALTERNATE NIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of chapter 263 of the acts of 1929, as amended, is

- 4 Any rule or regulation, adopted under this section, pro-
- 5 hibiting for any period of time between midnight of one day
- 6 and eight o'clock in the forenoon of the next day the parking
- 7 or standing of vehicles on the whole or any part or parts of
- 8 one or more streets, ways, highways, roads or parkways may
- 9 provide that it shall apply to the alternate sides thereof on
- 10 alternate days. No warning sign need be maintained in con-
- 11 nection with any rule or regulation so providing; nor shall
- 12 any such rule or regulation be subject to section two of chap-
- 13 ter eighty-five of the General Laws.
