AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CLASSIFICATIONS  
UNDER THE COMPULSORY MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSUR-  
ANCE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General  
2 Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at  
3 the end the following paragraphs:—

4 The commissioner in his classification of risks and deter-  
5 mination of premium charges shall place in the schedule of  
6 premium charges under class one any person under the age  
7 of twenty-five years who for a period of three full years has  
8 not been involved in an accident in which he has been de-  
9 termined to be at fault, and that the parent of any person in  
10 whose household there is such an operator under the age of  
11 twenty-five years shall be included in this classification.

12 The question of responsibility relating to an accident in  
13 which a person under the age of twenty-five years is involved  
14 shall be determined by the registrar of motor vehicles in ac-  
15 cordance with the provisions of chapter ninety A.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nine-  
2 teen hundred and fifty-eight.
