AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY FOR USE
AS A GOVERNOR'S MANSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commonwealth of Massachusetts, by the
2 state superintendent of buildings, is hereby authorized to
3 purchase certain land with the buildings thereon located on
4 Adams street in the city of Quincy and being the estate of
5 former mayor Perley Barbour to be used as a home for the
6 use of the governor of the commonwealth to be known as the
7 governor's mansion. For the purpose of purchasing said
8 property and to repair and fully equip the building there may
9 be expended such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

1 SECTION 2. When the work authorized by this act shall
2 have been completed, the building and grounds shall be main-
3 tained by the commonwealth, with the right in the governor
4 to select his own servants and employees, and maintain said
5 mansion as his home, the cost of maintenance to be borne by
6 the commonwealth in such amount as may be appropriated
7 therefor.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF REGISTRY FOR THE STATE OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, do hereby enact and declare that the Board of Registry for the State of Massachusetts, created by Chapter One Hundred and Sixty of the Acts of the Commonwealth of the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, shall be organized and shall have the following powers and duties:

Section 2. When the said board is organized by the act of the said board, the board shall be organized and shall have the following powers and duties:
