
By Mr. Tamkin of Boston, petition of Alvin C. Tamkin for legislation to ban sororities and fraternities at the University of Massachusetts which discriminate against certain students because of race, color, religion or nationality. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO SORORITIES AND FRATERNITIES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS DISCRIMINATING AGAINST CERTAIN STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All sororities and fraternities which are affli-
2 ated with the University of Massachusetts and have within
3 their national or local charters or by-laws language which
4 discriminates against a person because of his race, color,
5 religion, creed or nationality and/or which practice discrimi-
6 nation against a person because of his race, color, religion,
7 creed or nationality shall be banned from participating in
8 any and all activities and associations with the University of
9 Massachusetts.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on September first,
2 nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
