AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF THE JUDGES OF PROBATE AND INSOLVENCY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 217 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
 2 striking out section 34, as most recently amended by section 7  
 3 of chapter 733 of the acts of 1955, and inserting in place  
 4 thereof the following section:—

5 *Section 34.* The salaries of all judges of probate shall be  
 6 paid by the commonwealth and are hereby established as  
 7 follows:—
