RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF SAVINGS BANKS AND CO-OPERATIVE BANKS WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission to consist of
2 three members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, five members of the house of representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker thereof, and three persons to be
5 appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the pur-
6 poses of making a comprehensive investigation and study of
7 savings and co-operative banks within the commonwealth.

8 Said commission shall report to the general court the results
9 of its investigation and study, together with drafts of legis-
10 lation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by
11 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives
12 not later than the first Wednesday in December in the current
13 year.
