RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM CEILING INCOMES FOR ALL FEDERAL HOUSING PROJECTS FOR ALL FAMILY UNIT CLASSIFICATIONS.

Whereas, Many tenants of the federal housing projects have exceeded the present maximum ceiling income; and

Whereas, These tenants are now faced with eviction proceedings; and

Whereas, It is becoming more difficult to rent vacant apartments of the federal housing projects due to the present requirements of the maximum ceiling income; therefore be it

Resolved, That the General Court of Massachusetts memorializes the Congress of the United States to enact legislation providing for an increase in the maximum ceiling incomes for all federal housing projects for all family unit classifications; and be it further

Resolved, That copies of these resolutions be sent forthwith by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the President of the United States, to the presiding officers of each branch of Congress, and to the members thereof from this Commonwealth.
