AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR DUKES COUNTY SHERIFF, KEEPER OF DUKES COUNTY JAIL AND MATRON OF DUKES COUNTY JAIL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary the
- 2 salary of the sheriff of Dukes County shall be three thousand
- 3 six hundred dollars per annum; the salary of the keeper of
- 4 the Dukes County jail shall be two thousand dollars per
- 5 annum; and the salary of the matron of the Dukes County
- 6 jail shall be one thousand dollars per annum.
