RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY AN UNPAID SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO OBTAINING FEDERAL FUNDS AND ASSISTANCE TO IMPLEMENT THE ACTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN ELIMINATING SMOKE AND OTHER AIR POLLUTION NUISANCES.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission to consist of
2 two members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, three members of the house of representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker thereof, and three persons to be
5 appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the pur-
6 pose of making an investigation and study relative to obtain-
7 ing federal funds and assistance to implement the action of
8 the commonwealth in eliminating smoke and other air pollu-
9 tion nuisances. Said commission shall be provided with
10 quarters in the state house or elsewhere, and may expend such
11 sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said commission
12 shall report to the general court the results of its investigation
13 and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with
14 drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations
15 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
16 representatives on or before the last Wednesday of December
17 in the current year.
