AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AFFIXING THE DATE AND PLACE OF PROCESSING ON FROZEN FOODS OFFERED FOR SALE TO THE PUBLIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 94 of the ~~General~~ Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 184A the following section:—

3 *Section 184B.* Upon each package, bottle or other re-
4 ceptacle containing food in a frozen state there shall be a
5 label upon which shall be printed the date and place of
6 processing in type not smaller than eight point (brevier)
7 capitals. Whoever processes or packages frozen foods in
8 violation of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less
9 than one hundred nor more than five hundred dollars.
