AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF MEMBERS OF CITY OR TOWN POLICE DEPARTMENTS TRANSFERRING TO THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The salary of a member of a city or town police department
- 2 transferring to the metropolitan district commission police
- 3 shall be established as if his service as a member of such
