By Mr. Howard of Westminster, petition of Walter M. Wilcox and others (selectmen) that the town of Westminster be authorized to borrow money for the improvement of an existing school playground. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WESTMINSTER TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF AN EXISTING SCHOOL PLAYGROUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of improving, enlarging and
2 remodeling the existing school playground known as the
3 Westminster Memorial Athletic Field, the town of Westmin-
4 ster is authorized to borrow a sum of money not to exceed
5 twenty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes there-
6 for, which bonds shall bear on their face the words, Westmin-
7 ster Playground Improvement Loan, Act of 1957. Said loan
8 shall be paid in not more than five years from its date. In-
9 debtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the
10 statutory limit, but shall, except as provided herein, be sub-
11 ject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
