RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO RETARDED CHILDREN AND THE TRAINING FACILITIES AVAILABLE THEREFOR.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission established by
2 chapter seventy-seven of the resolves of nineteen hundred and
3 fifty-two, and most recently revived and continued by chapter
4 of the resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-
5 seven, shall, in making its investigation and study, consider
6 the subject matter of current house document numbered 1135,
7 relative to recreational programs for mentally retarded chil-
8 dren, and of current house document numbered 2023, relative
9 to reimbursement to cities and towns conducting classes for
10 certain handicapped children.
