RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO PROHIBITING THE SEIZURE ON AN EXECUTION ON A JUDGMENT AGAINST A CITY, TOWN, OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE COMMONWEALTH, OF PROPERTY OWNED IN THEIR OWN RIGHT BY INDIVIDUAL INHABITANTS OF THE CITY, TOWN, OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to investi-
2 gate the subject matter of current house document numbered
3 1842, relative to prohibiting the seizure on an execution on
4 a judgment against a city, town, or other political subdivi-
5 sion of the commonwealth, of property owned in their own
6 right by individual inhabitants of the city, town or political
7 subdivision of the commonwealth, and to include its conclu-
8 sions and recommendations in relation thereto, with drafts of
9 such legislation as may be necessary to give effect to the
10 same, in its annual report for the current year.
