AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE METHUEN POLICE RELIEF ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whenever a member of the Methuen Police Relief Associa-
2 tion, Incorporated, ceases to be a member of the Methuen
3 police department, he shall cease to be a member of said
4 association and shall no longer be entitled to any benefits
5 therefrom; provided, however, that any member of said
6 association who ceases to be a member of the Methuen police
7 department, by reason of being pensioned from said depart-
8 ment, shall within thirty days of such retirement be paid
9 from the funds of said association a sum of money equal to
10 the death benefit.
