AN ACT RELATIVE TO SALARIES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 241 of the acts of 1875 is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 5, as amended by section 2
3 of chapter 121 of the acts of 1933, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following section:—

5 *Section 5.* The school committee shall have the super-
6 vision and direction of the public schools, and shall exercise
7 the powers and perform the duties in relation to the care and
8 management of schools which are now exercised and performed
9 by the school committee of said city, except so far as they
10 may be changed or modified by this act, and shall have the
11 powers and discharge the duties which may hereafter be im-
12 posed by law upon the school committees of cities and towns.
13 They may elect teachers, and may discharge those now in
14 office, as well as those hereafter elected. They shall appoint
15 janitors for the school-houses, fix their compensation, desig-
16 nate their duties, and may discharge them at pleasure. They
17 may fix the compensation of the teachers, but the salaries
18 established at the commencement of each school year shall
19 not be increased during such year. No salary increase shall
20 be granted, nor shall the salary of any position be increased
21 unless such increases have been specifically designated in the
22 appropriation order.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not take effect unless accepted
2 by the school committee of the city of Boston. If accepted
3 by the said committee prior to January first, nineteen hun-

4 dred and fifty-eight, then this act shall take effect on January
5 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight. If accepted by the
6 said committee subsequent to January first, nineteen hundred
7 and fifty-eight, it shall take effect on the date of acceptance
8 by said committee.
