AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NANTUCKET TO APPROPRIATE A SUM OF MONEY FOR THE PURCHASE OF SHEEP COMMONS AND SHARES OF THE COMMON AND UNDIVIDED LANDS OF THE ISLAND OF NANTUCKET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Nantucket is hereby authorized
2 to raise and appropriate the sum of forty-five hundred dollars
3 for the purchase of sheep commons and shares of the common
4 and undivided lands of the island of Nantucket.

1 SECTION 2. The action of the inhabitants of the town of
2 Nantucket at its annual town meeting, held February nine-
3 teenth, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, in voting that the
4 sum of forty-five hundred dollars be raised and appropriated
5 for the purchase of said commons and land is hereby confirmed
6 and made valid to the same extent as if the provisions of sec-
7 tion one of this act had been in effect at the time such action
8 was taken.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
