1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission, known as
2 the commission on audit of state needs, established by chapter
3 thirty-eight of the resolves of the current year, shall, in the
4 course of its investigation and study, consider the subject
5 matter of so much of the Governor's Address (Senate, No. 1,
6 page 51), as relates to establishing the term of the budget
7 commissioner, director of personnel and classification and
8 comptroller, to run concurrent with that of the Governor;
9 of so much of the Governor's Address (Senate, No. 1, page 52),
10 as relates to a review of the state policies governing the issu-
11 ance of licenses and the establishment of fees therefor; and
12 of so much of the Address of the Governor (House, No. 1),
13 as relates to increasing departmental fees.
