AN ACT VALIDATING THE ACTS AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE TOWN OF UXBRIDGE RELATIVE TO THE ADOPTION OF ZONING BY-LAWS AND BUILDING ORDINANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The action of the selectmen of the town of
2 Uxbridge in placing upon the official ballot instead of placing

8 firmed and made valid, and the said zoning by-laws and
9 building ordinances are hereby validated to the same extent
10 as if the said question of adoption thereof had been voted
11 upon at the annual town meeting as provided for in section
12 six of chapter forty A of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
