To accompany the petition of Augustus Hemenway that the town of Milton be authorized to supply his premises in the town of Canton with water. Water Supply.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Milton to supply Water to the Premises of Augustus Hemenway in the Town of Canton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Milton may supply the
2 premises belonging to Augustus Hemenway situ-
3 ated in the town of Canton with water for fire
4 protection and for domestic and other purposes.
5 To enable said town to carry out the provisions
6 of this act it may construct, lay and maintain pipes
7 and hydrants under or upon any public or private
8 way, and along any such ways in said town of
9 Canton in such manner as not unnecessarily to
10 obstruct the same; and for the purpose of con-

11 structing, laying and maintaining, operating and
12 repairing such pipes and other works may dig up
13 such ways in such manner as to cause the least
14 hindrance to public travel on such ways; but all
15 things done upon such ways shall be subject to the
16 direction of the selectmen of the town of Canton.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
