

SENATE No. 130

To accompany the petition of E. H. Vaughan, city solicitor, that the city of Worcester be authorized to take land for widening and extending Madison street. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Worcester to take Land in connection with the Proposed Plan of widening and extending Madison Street.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Worcester is hereby au-
2 thorized to take in fee, in connection with the laying
3 out and construction of a proposed street extending
4 from Madison street to Canal street in said city,
5 the whole or parts of lots of land, not exceeding
6 feet in depth, on both the easterly
7 and westerly sides of said street as proposed to be
8 laid out.

1 SECTION 2. After so much of the land or property
2 as shall be taken under the authority of this act has

3 been appropriated for said street as is needed
 4 therefor, the street commissioner of said city may
 5 sell and convey by deeds, with or without restric-
 6 tions, the remaining portions of such land, if any,
 7 for such value or consideration as is approved by
 8 the mayor.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
 2 passage.
