

SENATE No. 232

To accompany the petition of Loyed E. Chamberlain for legislation to permit travelling expenses in certain cases for judges of probate. Legal Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To provide for Traveling Expenses of Judges of Probate and Insolvency in Certain Cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A judge of probate and insolvency
2 holding a session of court in another county than
3 his own, upon designation by the judge of such
4 other county, as now provided by law, shall, in addi-
5 tion to the compensation allowed by law, be allowed
6 ten cents a mile for travel out and home, to be paid
7 by the commonwealth upon certification by the
8 judge — or, if there is more than one judge, by the
9 first judge — of the county in which the designated
10 session is held.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
