## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Period of Incapacity for which Compensation may be paid for Injuries received by Certain Employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter seven hun-  
2 dred and fifty-one of the acts of the year nineteen  
3 hundred and eleven is hereby amended by striking  
4 out, in line two, the word " weeks ", and substitut-  
5 ing therefor the word: — days, — and by striking  
6 out, in line four, the words " weeks " and " fif-  
7 teenth ", and substituting therefor the words: —  
8 " days " and " third ", respectively, — so as to  
9 read as follows: — No compensation shall be paid  
10 under this act for any injury which does not inca-

11 pacitate the employee for a period of at least two  
 12 days from earning full wages, but if incapacity ex-  
 13 tends beyond the period of two days, compensation  
 14 shall begin on the third day after the injury.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
 2 passage.
