AN ACT

Relative to lowering the Metropolitan Water Mains in
Chelsea Creek.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan water and sewerage
2 board is hereby authorized to lower the metropolitan
3 water mains in Chelsea creek to a sufficient depth to per-
4 mit the carrying out of the improvements in said creek
5 provided for by an act of the congress of the United States
6 passed in nineteen hundred and twelve, and may sink
7 shafts, construct a tunnel and do any other act or thing
8 necessary to comply with the requirements of said act.

1 SECTION 2. To meet the expenditures incurred under
2 the provisions of this act the treasurer and receiver gen-
3 eral shall issue from time to time, upon the request of
4 said board, bonds in the name and behalf of the com-
5 monwealth, to be designated on the face thereof Metro-
6 politan Water Loan, to an amount not exceeding seventy-
7 five thousand dollars in addition to the amount of such
8 bonds heretofore authorized under the provisions of chap-

9 ter four hundred and eighty-eight of the acts of the year
10 eighteen hundred and ninety-five and acts in amendment
11 thereof and in addition thereto and the provisions of said
12 chapter four hundred and eighty-eight and of said acts
13 shall apply to this additional loan.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
