

SENATE No. 551

To accompany the petition of James P. Timilty that the city of Boston be authorized to pay an annuity to the widow of Michael D. Greene. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to pay an Annuity to the
Widow of Michael D. Greene.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized
2 to pay an annuity of not more than three hundred dol-
3 lars to Alice Greene, widow of Michael D. Greene, so
4 long as she remains unmarried. Said Michael D.
5 Greene, who was a lieutenant in the fire department of
6 the city of Boston, while in the discharge of his duties
7 as a member and officer of said fire department, received
8 injuries on the fourteenth day of August, nineteen hun-
9 dred and eleven, which resulted in his death. The fire
10 commissioner of said city may from time to time order
11 such annuity to be reduced.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by the city council of the city of Boston.
