SECTION 33A. Sections two and three of chapter two hundred and forty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and ninety-four are hereby repealed.

SECTION 34. Any licenses issued annually pursuant to chapter one hundred and sixty-nine A and chapter two hundred and fifty-five E of the General Laws in effect on the effective date of this act and scheduled to expire on April first shall be deemed to be in effect until June first.

Chapter 360. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CARVER, MARION, WAREHAM REGIONAL REFUSE DISPOSAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section forty-four F of chapter forty of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the Carver, Marion, Wareham Regional Refuse Disposal District is hereby authorized to purchase land in the town of Rochester for the purposes of the district and to construct thereon and equip a refuse disposal facility and to enter into contracts necessary therefor.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 361. AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately provide for the development of certain land in the town of Framingham, therefore it is declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 36 of chapter 85 of the acts of 1994 is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- Any fee, easement, lease or any other interest in land conveyed pursuant to this section shall be granted to the town of Medfield for nominal consideration only.

SECTION 2. The first sentence of section 2 of chapter 678 of the acts of 1987, as amended by section 2 of chapter 121 of the acts of 1994, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 5, the word "eighty" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- two hundred.
