To accompany the petition of Michael J. McEttrick that a commission be appointed for the purpose of securing employment for graduates of all educational institutions. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

AN ACT

To establish a Board of Commissioners to promote the Interests of Graduates of Certain Educational Institutions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The governor, with the advice and
2 consent of the council, shall, on or before the first
3 day of July, nineteen hundred and fifteen, appoint
4 five suitable persons to constitute a board of com-
5 missioners for the promotion, encouragement, com-
6 mercial and business advancement of graduates
7 of merit of all recognized schools and institutions
8 of education within the commonwealth. It shall
9 be the duty of said board to establish a policy
10 whereby positions may be secured for such gradu-
11 ates in the various commercial, industrial and

12 financial institutions in the several cities and towns
13 of the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. Suitable clerical assistance may be
2 employed by said board and compensations to be
3 paid from the treasury of the commonwealth shall
4 be fixed by the governor and council.
