6 street, East Boston, Massachusetts, by reason of an ex-  
7 plosion which occurred at the East Boston metropolitan  
8 pumping station on June first, nineteen hundred and  
9 fourteen. Payment shall be made from the North  
10 Metropolitan Sewerage Maintenance Fund.
