AN ACT

Relative to the Expense of rebuilding a Certain Sea Wall
on Broad Canal in the City of Cambridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The estate of John J. Horgan is hereby
2 authorized to make a deduction of fifteen hundred dollars
3 from the payment to be made the commonwealth of one
4 third part of the expense incurred by the metropolitan
5 park commission, under authority of section one of chap-
6 ter seven hundred and forty-one of the acts of the year
7 nineteen hundred and thirteen.

1 SECTION 2. Section two of chapter seven hundred and
2 forty-one of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
3 thirteen is hereby amended by striking out in the third
4 line the words "seventy-five hundred", and inserting in
5 place thereof the words:— nine thousand.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
