Bill accompanying the petition of Thomas J. Giblin that the sale and use of broken, canned, powdered and evaporated eggs be prohibited or regulated. Public Health. January 7.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To prohibit the Manufacture, Sale and Use of Broken,
Canned, Powdered and Evaporated Eggs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to manufacture, sell,
2 offer for sale or prepare for sale any broken, canned,
3 powdered or evaporated eggs, or other like preparation
4 of eggs, or to use the same in making, cooking or treating
5 any articles of food or drink.

1 SECTION 2. Violation of the provisions of this act
2 shall be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more
3 than one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment for not
4 more than one year, or by both such fine and imprison-
5 ment.
